A TEAM APPROACH

The hospice team works closely with the physician to coordinate hospice care that meets the needs of the patient and family.

The hospice team is made up of specially-trained nurses, home health aides, rehabilitation therapists, nutritionists, social workers, bereavement counselors, pastoral care, volunteers and a medical director who oversees all medical care.

VOLUNTEER SUPPORT

Cranberry Hospice volunteers are very important members of the hospice team, providing emotional support to patients and family members. They receive specialized training that prepares them for many volunteer functions, including visiting with patients so that family members can leave the home to do errands and more. Whether it's running to the grocery store, taking a much-needed nap or going for a long walk, family members have peace of mind in knowing that their loved ones are "in good hands" with Cranberry Hospice volunteers.

BEREAVEMENT PROGRAMS
